Conditions:

Fees are payable monthly, in advance. Any extra sessions attended which have not been pre-booked will be billed the following month. Fees change in the month following a child reaching 2 years and 3 years.

All care (included extended days) must be booked one month in advance. However, in an emergency, additional care will be provided at late notice.

The non-means-tested Government Early Years' Funding will be given to all children at the appropriate age. EYF can be used for any sessions between the hours of 7.30am – 6pm. There will be no conditions imposed for those children who solely use their early education funding at school.

The means tested Government Early Years Funding will be given to all children from 9 months whose parents qualify and have obtained the appropriate code.

Notice to withdraw a child is one month or one month's fees payable in lieu of notice.

Fees are charged regardless of whether or not a child attends.

Opening Times

The Nursery is open at all times other than Bank Holidays and closes 23 December 2026 and re-opens on 4 January 2027.

The School will continue to cover 10% of the VAT for the Autumn Term 2026. Thereafter, from January 2027, an extra 5% will be added to fees, increasing the parents' contribution to 15%. The School will continue to cover the remaining 5%.

After-School Care and Overnight Boarding

In addition to Breakfast and Supper Clubs, the School offers other 'cover' for day pupils' parents who are unable to collect their children at the end of the School day.

- **Pre-Prep Department**

Children in Classes 2, 3 and 4 who have older siblings in the Prep School, and children in Classes 3 and 4 who are taking part in After-School Clubs, may stay at School for drink and biscuits until 4.30pm without charge. Pre-Prep children who are in School post 3.30pm who do not meet the above criteria will be charged at a rate of £3.52 per half-hour. After 4.30 your child/children should be booked in for care which is charged at £3.52 per half hour. There is an option for them to have tea which should also be **prebooked** and is charged at £3.10. Post 5.30pm children will be taken to our Junior Boarding Wing. The cost of this cover is also £3.52 per half-hour.

- **Prep School**

Children in the Prep School may stay until 5.30pm for either Clubs and Societies or to do prep. After this time, they will be formally 'booked in' for after-School care and the cost of this is £3.52 per half-hour.

- **Weekly Overnight Boarding**

All children may stay for overnight boarding during the term. This must be booked through the School Office to enable us to check on bed availability. On the morning of the stay, an overnight case should be left in the School Office.

Boarding out of term-time is by special arrangement only with the Headmaster and is offered in extenuating circumstances only.

All requests for Overnight Boarding or After-School Care must be made through the School Office.
